Uniforms

- Where do I buy my child's uniform?
 - Ibiley Uniforms: School will host on campus sales throughout the year
 - Online orders: www.ibiley.com Phone number: 305-625-8050
- What type of shoes does my child have to wear?
 - **Solid Black Shoes** (Example: Mary Janes for girls or Loafers for boys.)
 - Socks white/navy socks. Girls can wear knee-high socks. All white socks must have the school logo.
- Can students wear sneakers?
 - Yes, for Physical Education **only**. Sneakers must be solid black or solid White.
- Do students need P.E. uniforms?
 - Yes. P.E. uniforms are required and must be purchased at Ibiley Uniforms.
- What type of book bag can be brought to school?
 - Any type of book bag is accepted.
- Are students issued Student Identification Cards (IDs)?
 - Yes. Students are required to wear their student id as part of the required daily student uniform.

Arrival and Dismissal

- What time do students have to be in school? What time is dismissal?
 - Arrival: School begins at 8:30 a.m. School opens at 7:00 a.m. for those who are interested in before-care. Students not registered in before-care may be dropped off any-time between 7:45- 8:30 a.m.
 - Dismissal: All students who are not registered in after-school care and are picked up late will be charged a late fee. Our dismissal policy **DOES NOT** permit students to be released from school 30 minutes prior to their scheduled dismissal time.
 - **K-1st Grade**: 2:30 p.m. **2nd-5th Grade**: 3:30 p.m.
 - Wednesdays are EARLY RELEASE: Dismissal: **K-1st Grade**: 2:00 p.m. **2nd-5th Grade**: 2:30 p.m.
 - Parents will be provided with a student decal which will be used to scan at the time of dismissal. Parents must drive through the carport.

Safety and Security

- Parents/visitors who arrive between the hours of 8:45 a.m. – 1:45 p.m. must enter through single point of entry, which is located S. Goodman Road entrance. You will be greeted by a law enforcement officer who will then advise the main office of your visit.
- All visitors must check-in with our Concierge Pad system using a valid form of identification (i.e. Driver's License). Once you have been checked in, you will receive a visitor's badge that must be worn while on campus.

Communication

- School Phone Number: TBA or (305) 225-0444. A new number will be released when the school year begins.
- Can my child bring a cellphone or electronic device to school?
 - Students should not bring cellphones or electronic devices. They are not allowed to be used in school. If a student is caught using any electronic device, it will be confiscated and a parent will have to pick it up after-school in the main office.
- What is the best way to communicate with my teacher?
 - Please send your teacher an e-mail or a written note in the school agenda. Allow up to 48 hours for a response.

Volunteer Hours

- Are Parent/Guardians required to volunteer?
 - Yes, parent/guardians are required to complete a minimum of ten (10) hours per school year.
- How do you become a school volunteer?
 - Visit our website and click "Become a School Volunteer" under the tab "Parents/Students." You will be redirected to the "AcadeMir Charter Schools Volunteer Clearance" program through ConciergePad. Fill out the volunteer registration form and select "LEVEL I Basic Background Check." A \$7 fee will apply.
 - After filling out the volunteer registration form, you will receive an email with additional steps that must be completed before being cleared. Once you have been cleared, you will receive an email and the main office will be notified.
- How can I complete my volunteer hours?
 - You may volunteer at any school family event by asking your teacher or signing up online.

- No, we do not follow the Osceola calendar. However, we do follow the SDOC grading period start and end dates.
- Please refer to the AcadeMir Preparatory of ChampionsGate calendar for early release dates, holidays, Teacher Planning Days, and Seasonal Breaks.
- We do follow the SDOC Code of Student Conduct and Student Progression Plan for our Student's Behavior and Expectations.

Homework

- Homework will be given in class and assignments will be posted on your class google website.
- Homework may have to be printed. All homework must be brought in daily.
- All students will have agendas. In these agendas all homework is written daily. Please check agendas daily!

Food

- Can we bring cupcakes for my child's birthday?
 - No. Due to high allergies, classroom birthday celebrations are not permitted.
- Can I bring my child lunch during school hours?
 - No. Outside fast food may not be delivered to students for lunch. (Example: Burger King, McDonald's etc.)
- What if my child has a food allergy? (AcadeMir Preparatory of ChampionsGate is a peanut-free school)
 - Parents must notify the school immediately and complete proper documentation including Allergy Plan. Classrooms will be identified and labeled if they have a student with a food allergy.
 - If your child has a food allergy, cafeteria seating accommodations will be made for them. Teachers will also make their own classroom adjustments for your child's safety.
- Hot meals will be available for purchase daily. Monthly payments can be made to your child's meal account. Visit our school store and click on "Lunch" to make a payment.

Medication

- What if my child needs medication?
 - All medication must be dropped off in the office by the parent. Children may not carry their own medication. Medications need to be administered in the main office. The official SDOC Authorization for Medication ([Form FC-600-2034](#)) must be completed by your child's physician. This form can be given to you in the main office.

Emergency Contact

- Emergency Contact forms are filled out at the beginning of the year. Make sure information is accurate at all times.
- What if I need someone to pick up my child and they are not written on the emergency contact card?
 - For the safety of your child, any changes regarding dismissal a written letter and/or email must be turned in to the main office staff for approval. Your letter/email must include a picture of your license and with the name of who will be picking up your child. A proper I.D. will be asked for at the time of pick-up.

Health & Safety

- If my student is sick?
 - they must stay home.
 - Symptoms among children include fever, headache, sore throat, cough, fatigue, nausea/vomiting, and diarrhea. If a child has a temperature over 100.4 degrees (without fever-reducing medication), the parent/caregiver should wait fifteen (15) minutes and recheck the temperature to confirm if it remains elevated.
 - If a student is sick including presenting with a temperature above 100.4 degrees and experiencing COVID-19 symptoms they must stay home, contact their health care provider, and the parent must notify the school immediately.

P.E. Days (Physical Education)

- Every grade level has a designated PE day. All students must come to school dressed in their PE uniform on their designated day below. Students will remain in the PE uniform all day.
- PE Scheduled Uniform Days:
 - Kindergarten- First Grade: Tuesday
 - Second-Third Grade: Wednesday
 - Fourth-Fifth Grade: Thursday
- Students must bring AcadeMir duffle bag on a daily basis with black sneakers for daily Physical Education block.

After-School Programs/ Enrichment Programs

- After-school program is open Monday-Friday immediately after dismissal until 6:00 p.m. It is not open when the school is closed. After-care program provides a snack, homework assistance and enrichment activities to students.
- Enrichment programs are offered after-school at an additional cost.
 - Examples of enrichment programs:
 - Gymnastics
 - Volleyball
 - Soccer
 - Martial Arts
 - Basketball
 - Chorus
 - Cheerleading
 - Art
 - Dance
 - Academic Tutoring
 - Yoga
 - Music
 - Robotics/Coding
 - Clubs: Science/STEM, Gardening, Student Council, Honor Society

Registrations for these programs open in September to begin in October. Payments are made online within the "Enrichments" registration period in our "School Store" under the "Enrichments/Clubs" tab.

- All students registered in after-school or in an enrichment program **MUST** purchase our school "CHUBB Insurance." Students who do not have this insurance may **NOT** stay after-school.
